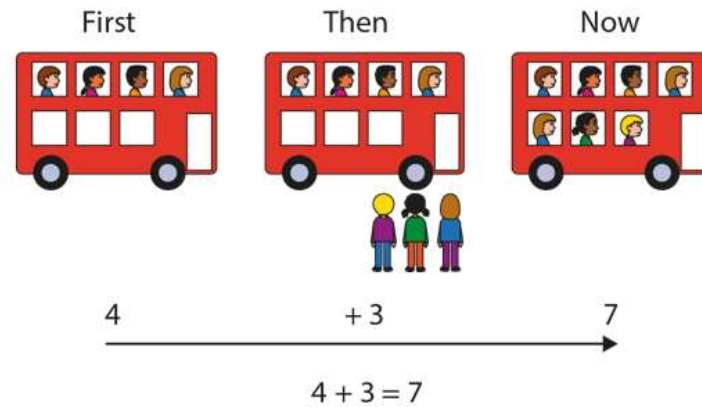

Prior Learning

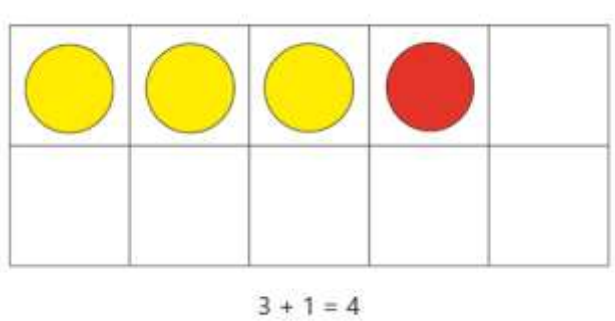
- I can compose numbers up to 10.
