I will be able to develop my jumping, landing and balancing skills.

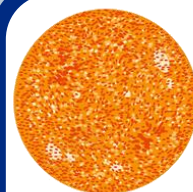
I will be able to share in a celebration with my friends and people around me.

I will be able to explore materials in order to create artwork.

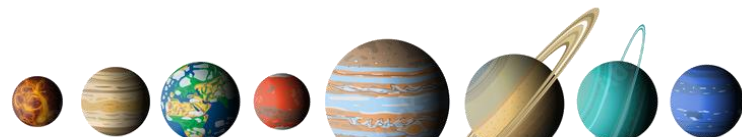
I will be able to explore new technologies such as Beebots.

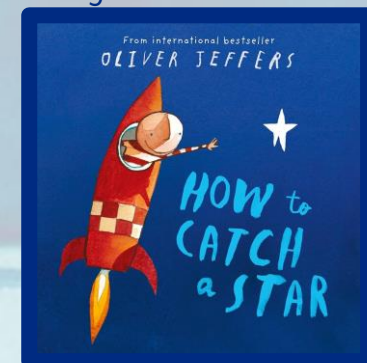
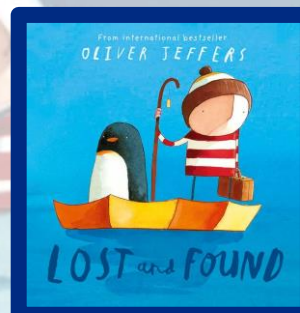
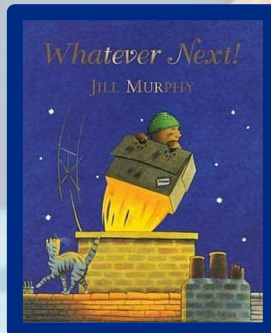
**Beebots** are robots that can follow instructions that are **programmed** into them. *Perhaps you could practise by giving your child a set of three instructions and observing if they remember them!*
