I will be able to develop my jumping, landing and balancing skills.


I will be able to share in a celebration with my friends and people around me.

Beebots are robots that can follow instructions that are **programmed** into them. Perhaps you could practise by giving your child a set of three instructions and observing if they remember them!


Diwali - Hindu festival of lights Sunday 12th November 2023


Hannukah - Jewish festival commemorating the recovery of Jersualem 7th December - 15th December
