- I can write simple phrases and sentences that can be read by others.

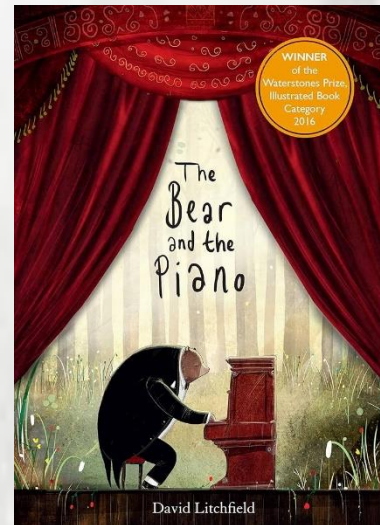
Milestones

Key Vocabulary

- Full stop** – punctuation used at the end of a sentence.
- Adjective** – a describing word eg. Crunchy, icy, maroon
- Narrative** – a story.
- Question mark** – ? punctuation to show a question ending.
- Conjunctions** – a word used to connect sentences e.g. 'and'.
