The spoon is **heavier** than the feather.



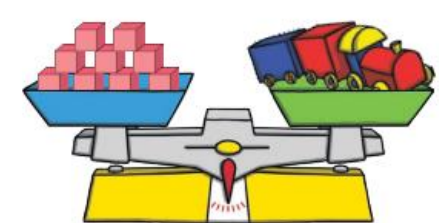
The toy car and book have **the same** mass.

The toy train has a mass of 9 cubes.
