Full stop – punctuation used at the end of a sentence.

**Factual adjective –** a describing word e.g. Vegetable eating herbivore


**Suffixes-** added to root words to change the meaning of the word e.g. quick, quicker, quickest

**Non fiction** – facts and information text.

**Question mark** – punctuation to show a question ending with a '?' e.g. What does it eat?

Conjunctions - a word used to connect sentences e.g. 'and'.
