Prior Learning

I can write sentences by:

- saying out loud what I am going to write about
- composing a sentence orally before writing it
- sequencing sentences to form short narratives
- re-reading what I have written to check that it makes sense
- discuss what I have written with the teacher or other pupils
- read my writing aloud, clearly enough to be heard by my peers and the teacher

I can leave spaces between words

I can join words and clauses using 'and'

I can begin to punctuate sentences using a capital letter and a full stop, question mark or exclamation mark

I can use a capital letter for names of people, places, the days of the week, and the personal pronoun 'I'

I can learn the grammar for year 1

I can use grammatical terminology when discussing my writing

Milestones

I will be able to write a narrative about personal experiences and those of others (real and fictional)

I will be able to write about real events

I will be able to plan or say out loud what I am going to write about

I will be able to writing down ideas and/or key words, including new vocabulary

I will be able to encapsulate what I want to say, sentence by sentence

I will be able to make simple additions, revisions and corrections to my own writing

I will be able to read aloud what I have written with appropriate intonation to make the meaning clear

I will be able to learn how to use both familiar and new punctuation correctly, including full stops, capital letters, exclamation marks, question marks, commas for lists and apostrophes for contracted forms and the possessive (singular)

I will learn how to use:

- expanded noun phrases to describe [for example, the blue butterfly]
- the present and past tenses correctly and consistently
- subordination (using when, if, that, or because) and co-ordination (using or, and, or but)
- the grammar for Year 2
- some features of written Standard English

I will be able to use and understand grammatical terminology when discussing my writing

Key vocabulary

Non-Fiction – Writing that is about real events and facts

Biography – The life of a person written by someone else

Chronological – Following the order in which a series of events happen

Heading – Words written at the top of a text as a title


Sub-heading – A word, phrase or sentence that is used to introduce part of a text.





